

THE FORM AND MEANING OF USING SLANG IN THE COMMENT COLUMN OF THE TIKTOK ACCOUNT @FADILJAIDI

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ABSTRACT

This study aims to describe the form and meaning of the use of slang in the comment column of the Tiktok account @Fadiljaidi. This research uses a qualitative approach with a content analysis method. The research data is in the form of netizens' comments that contain slang on @Fadiljaidi's Tiktok account. Data collection is done through documentation techniques and note-taking techniques by taking screenshots of relevant comments. Data analysis uses the Miles and Huberman model which includes data collection, data reduction, data presentation, and conclusion drawn. The results of the study show that the use of slang in the comment column of the Tiktok account @Fadiljaidi consists of five forms, namely acronyms, abbreviations, contractions, clippings, and a variety of walikan. The acronym form was found as many as 10 data, abbreviations of 11 data, contraction of 8 data, clipping of 8 data, and a variety of guardians of 3 data. The slang used is generally formed through the process of shortening words, combining syllables, eliminating phonemes, and reversing the order of phonemes. In addition, the use of slang in the comment column has meanings related to the expression of feelings, familiarity, jokes, and social identities of social media users. This study concludes that slang on social media, especially Tiktok, develops dynamically following the creativity and communication needs of users in creating relaxed and intimate interactions.

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INTRODUCTION

Language is the main means of human communication, both verbally and in writing. In a sociolinguistic perspective, language is understood not only as a communication system, but also as a social phenomenon that

continues to evolve according to the dynamics of society. Language changes can occur in terms of form, meaning, and use along with the development of the times and the communication needs of the speakers. The development of information and communication technology, especially social media, has brought a significant need in the pattern of language use. The presence of platforms such as Instagram, Whatsapp, Tiktok, and Facebook opens up new interaction spaces that are faster and wider. This condition encourages the emergence of various variations of languages that are used informally by users, especially the younger generation.

Slang is a form of language variation that is growing rapidly in social media. This language emerged as a result of the creativity of users in creating more relaxed, expressive, and easy-to-understand forms of communication in certain communities. The use of slang also often involves mixing Indonesian with foreign and regional languages (Mafiroh et al., 2024). The main characteristic of slang is its high flexibility and not tied to standard language rules. Balqis et al., (2022) states that slang can undergo changes in meaning according to the context of its use. This shows that slang has a dynamic nature that is influenced by the creativity and social interaction of its users. In addition to being a means of communication, slang also functions as a means of forming social identity. Its users can reflect the closeness, familiarity, and membership of a person in a certain group. In the context of social media, slang is often used to strengthen interaction and solidarity between users. However, the widespread use of slang also poses a number of problems. One of them is concern about the decline in the use of Indonesian language in accordance with good and correct rules. Dewi et al., (2023) mentioned that the influence of the social environment and the media can affect people's language patterns, especially in formal situations.

According to Muslich, (2008) The emergence of new terms or the formation of new words in language occurs in two ways, namely morphological and non-morphological processes. Morphological processes include affixation, reduplication, and pluralization, while processes outside morphology include acronyms, abbreviations, contractions, clippings, and various guardians. This shows that language develops not only through standard rules, but also through the creativity of its speakers. This research uses processes outside of morphology because the data studied is in the form of slang in the TikTok comment column, which many appear in the form of abbreviations, shortening, and word reversals. These forms are more in line with the character of fast, concise, and informal digital communication. Therefore, the focus of this research is right to explain how slang is formed and used in the context of social media.

Tiktok is the most widely used social media by teenagers. According to Putri et al., (2022) the social media app Tiktok has been downloaded more than 100 million times through *Google Play Store*. Meanwhile, data from the Ministry of Tourism and Creative Economy noted that the number of Tiktok users in Indonesia reached between 30 and 70 million people. The uniqueness of Tiktok's appeal compared to other social media platforms makes it a relevant subject of research. The platform allows users to create short videos enriched with music or short captions, making the content more dynamic and easy to understand. In addition, the comment feature on Tiktok facilitates a direct response from other users to the content viewed. These comments tend to be more numerous than other photo-based platforms, as videos give an authentic impression of real events. Typically, these comments often contain slang which is a mixture of regional languages, foreign languages, or variations of Indonesian. This form of language spreads quickly and often goes viral first on Tiktok compared to other social media platforms.

One of the creators who is active on Tiktok and attracts a lot of interaction is the Tiktok account @Fadiljaidi. Fadil Muhammad Jaidi, born in Bekasi on October 17, 1994, is a former child actor who is now a famous singer, content creator, and celebrity. The Tiktok account @Fadiljaidi has 16.3 million followers who have been active on Tiktok since 2020, by creating spontaneous humorous content and using slang so that it can attract millions of followers. This phenomenon can be seen in the comment column, where netizens often use slang and emojis to express their anger, jokes, and group identity, thus strengthening the bond between Fadhil and his fans. According to Dewi et al., (2023) This account shows the use of slang in the digital world, which not only serves as a communication tool

but also as a means to express emotions, attitudes, and the formation of group identities in online communities. These elements reflect the similarity of backgrounds and social closeness between the members.

Research on the variety of languages has been carried out by previous researchers, namely, Finalosa and Fikri, (2024), Anindya and Rondang, (2020), Ulya, (2017). Previous research relevant to this study has a similar focus, namely the analysis of slang forms used by adolescents. Finalosa & Fikri, (2024) In his research entitled *The Use of Slang in Tiktok Social Media Comment Columns* Found 114 forms of slang in 94 comments analyzed, consisting of 10 varieties of slang, namely abbreviations, absorption, acronyms, metathesis, contraction, decapitation, foreign language, improvisation of the original word, formation of new words, and monophthongization. The most widely used slang is foreign forms and contractions. In this study, the influence of globalization is very strong, especially because of social media, movies, and online games, so that foreign slang is considered cool and modern. Furthermore, Anindya & Rondang, (2020) in his research *Forms of Slang Among Instagram Social Media Users*. The findings in this study are the forms of slang words used on Instagram including various types such as, *Akronim*, *Abbreviation* (omission of certain letters), *Contractions* (combining words into one short form), *Clipping* (shortening of the word), *Variety of guardians* (the words behind the arrangement), *Use of foreign languages* (borrowed from other languages), *Asosiasi* (A change in meaning due to similarities), *Monoclonization* (converting vowels to one vowel), *Vocal letter dissipation*, *Words formed from improvisation of original words*, *New words created through the creativity of social media users*. Ulya, (2017) in his research *The Form and Function of Various Slang for Metropolitan Metropolitan Teenagers (Case Study of the Use of Various Slang for Students of SMA Negeri 66 Jakarta)* Identify several processes of language formation, namely, metathesis, reduction, hypercorrection, and adaptation. In addition, word formation also includes morphological processes, addition and insertion of phonemes or syllables, acronyms, abbreviations, and symbolization. Other findings show the existence of processes related to meaning change, onomatopoeia, language borrowing, and the formation of new words. In terms of function, the use of language includes emotive, conative, referential, and fateful functions.

Regarding this explanation, there is a similarity in this study, namely the subject in this study is in the form of slang words used by teenagers. The difference is in the object of this research which focuses on slang words found in the comment column of the Tiktok account, especially on the Tiktok account @Fadiljaidi. The novelty found in this study is the discovery of various forms of slang words that are increasingly diverse. Therefore, this study identifies the forms and meanings of slang found in the comment column of tiktok accounts.

METHOD

This study uses qualitative research with a content analysis method (*Content analysis*). The qualitative approach was chosen because this study aims to understand the phenomenon of using slang in the comment column of the Tiktok account @Fadiljaidi in depth through the description of the words and the context of their use. Moleong, (2005:6) states that qualitative research is an approach that seeks to understand the whole human experience through descriptions in real contexts. Meanwhile, the content analysis method is used because this study focuses on the process of identification, classification, and analysis of the forms and meanings of slang found in user interactions in the Tiktok comment column. According to Bungin, (2017) Content analysis is a systematic and objective method to analyze the content of messages and speakers' behavior in communication.

The research was carried out on the comment column of the Tiktok account @Fadiljaidi as the object of the research, the selection of the account was based on the high user interaction and the use of many variations of slang in the comment column. The research data is in the form of netizens' comments that contain slang vocabulary on @Fadiljaidi's Tiktok account. Mahsun, (2017) states that linguistic research data can be in the form of various linguistic phenomena that are in accordance with the research focus. The source of data in this study was obtained

directly from the comment column of the Tiktok account @Fadiljaidi. Muhammad, (2014) Explains that data sources are everything that can provide information related to the object of research, whether in the form of documents, places, or phenomena that are relevant to the research. The main instrument in this study is the researcher himself (*human instrument*) which plays a role in collecting, identifying, classifying, and analyzing slang data. In addition, the study also used supporting instruments in the form of mobile phones, screenshots of comments, and stationery to help the documentation and data recording process.

Data collection techniques are carried out through documentation techniques and recording techniques. Sugiyono, (2014) Explains that documentation is a data collection technique through documents, writings, and images related to certain events. In this study, the documentation technique was carried out by taking screenshots of comments on Tiktok accounts @Fadiljaidi using mobile phones to facilitate digital data storage. Furthermore, the note-taking technique is used to record important data related to the slang variations found in the comment column. Stuart O'Neill (2015) stated that the recording technique is carried out after the data collection process as an effort to store and group relevant data. The recording process is carried out in conjunction with documentation activities so that the data obtained is more systematic and accurate.

The data analysis technique in this study uses the Miles and Huberman data analysis model (in Ardianto, 2010) which includes four stages, namely data collection, data reduction, data presentation, and conclusion drawn. The data collection stage was carried out by collecting comments containing slang. Furthermore, the data is reduced by selecting and grouping the data according to the category of slang forms and meanings. The data that has been selected is then presented in descriptive form to facilitate the interpretation process. The final stage of analysis is carried out through drawing conclusions based on the results of the interpretation of the data that has been analyzed. The conclusion is prepared descriptively to explain the form and meaning of the use of slang in the comment column of the Tiktok account @Fadiljaidi. To maintain the validity of the data, this study uses observation diligence techniques as stated by (Moleong, 2010) Namely by carefully and repeatedly observing the data obtained so that the research results are more accurate and accountable.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

Based on the problems regarding the form and meaning of the use of slang that have been described in the previous section, the researcher explained the results of the analysis of the data on the form and meaning of slang found in the comment column of the Tiktok @Fadiljaidi account. These findings are in line with the theory Muslich, (2008) which includes acronyms, abbreviations, contractions, clippings, and various walikan.

Acronyms

The results of the research on slang analysis in the comment column of the Tiktok account @Fadiljaidi found 10 forms of acronyms. According to Muslich, (2008) Acronym is a form of shortening words that is done by combining certain syllables or parts of several words to produce a new form that can be spoken and written like a single word. The slang data of the acronym form is presented in table 1 below.

Based on the data in the table above, the slang form of acronyms in the comment column of the Tiktok account @Fadiljaidi mostly formed from two syllables. The syllables usually use the Indonesian form. Gercep said in data (1), the comment was written by @jip account. The word *Gercep* is formed from the first syllable "Motion" and the first syllable "Fast". The word *Gercep* refers to the meaning or meaning of a person who does everything quickly or not slowly. Next is the word *Asbun*. *Asbun* in data (2), comments were written by @Nanadd account. The word *Asbun* is an acronym slang formed from the first syllable "Origin" and the first syllable "Sound". In everyday use, the word *Asbun* has the meaning of speaking carelessly without thinking first or without knowing the actual facts. In short, the word *Asbun* is used to refer to someone who speaks carelessly without a clear basis.

Next is the word *Gabut*. *Gabut* said in (3), the comment was written by @Muaindah account. The word *Gabut* is an acronym formed from the first syllable "Gaji" and the first syllable "Buta". *Lexically blind salary* is the salary received by a person even if they do not do some or all of their work. However, the use of the word *Gabut* in slang is to describe the state of a person who is saturated, bored, or even lazy. Next is the word *Sosmed*. *Sosmed* said in data (4), the comments were written by @vinca account. The word *Social Media* stands for the word *Social Media* which undergoes the process of forming words in the form of acronyms. The acronym is formed by the first syllable "Social" and the first syllable "Media". This term is used in daily life to refer to platforms such as Tiktok, Instagram, Whatsapp, and others that are used to communicate and search for various information.

Salfok said in data (5), the comment was written by @eserjeeeee account. The word *Salfok* is an acronym slang formed from the first syllable "False" and the first syllable "Focus". This term has a meaning, namely a person's attention that is instead focused on things that should not be or are not the main thing. In short, the word *salfok* is a condition of our focus that deviates to other things. Furthermore, said *Caper*. *Caper* said in data (6), the comment was written by @Zai account. The word *Caper* is an acronym formed from the first syllables "Search" and "Attention". The term *Caper* has a meaning, namely the attitude of a person who deliberately does something so that others will notice. In short, the word *caper* is an attempt to attract the attention of others. Furthermore, *Mager* said in data (7), the comment was written by the panda @anak account. The word *Mager* is an acronym formed from the first syllable "Laziness" and the first syllable "Gerak". The term *mager* has a meaning, namely laziness to do something or laziness to move.

Next is the word *Bucin*. *Bucin* said in (8), the comment was written by the @BenyHusin account. The word *Bucin* is an acronym formed from the first syllable, namely "Slave" and "Love". The term *bucin* has the meaning of someone who is too crazy about a partner to tend to be excessive in attitude. *Bocil* said in (9), the comment was written by @_geminigrill06 account. The word *Bocil* is an acronym formed from the first syllable, namely "Boy" and the last syllable, "Kecil". The term *bocil* has the meaning of a small child or a term for children who are still young

and usually this term is often used in daily conversations or in social media. Furthermore, said Gamon. Gamon said in (10), the comment was written by the @RHS AUDIO account. The word *Gamon* is an acronym formed from the first syllable, namely "Fail" and "Move On". The term *gamon* has a meaning, namely the state of a person who still finds it difficult to forget someone or their past. This is usually related to romantic relationships.

Abbreviated

The results of the research on slang analysis in the comment column of the Tiktok account @Fadiljaidi found 11 forms of abbreviations. According to Muslich, (2008) Abbreviation is a form of shortening a word that is done by taking one phoneme or one letter from a certain word or phrase, then compiling it into a new form that can be spoken or written as a word. The slang data of the abbreviated form is presented in table 2. The following.

Based on the data in the table above, there are 10 forms of abbreviation derived from English, namely *cod, lol, btw, otw, grwm, fyp, cmiiw, pov, oot, fyi*. Then there is 1 form of abbreviation that comes from Indonesian, namely the word *php*. *Cod* said in data (1), the comment was written by @_Onyx account. The word *Cod* is an abbreviated form of slang formed from the combination of each of the first phonemes "Cash On Delivery". *This word comes from English which has the meaning of a payment method where the buyer pays for the goods when the goods have arrived in hand. So in short, Cod* it is pay on the spot when the goods are received. Next said *Lol*. The word *Lol* in data (2), the comment was written by the @D4vd account. The word *Lol* is an abbreviation formed from the combination of each of the first phonemes "Laughing Out Loud". *This word comes from English which means to laugh out loud or very funny. In everyday use, the word Lol* is used to indicate that something is funny or makes you laugh, even if sometimes it is just a casual expression. Furthermore, the word *Btw* in data (3), the comment was written by the @its.me account. The word *Btw* comes from English and is formed from the combination of each of the first phonemes "By The Way". *The term has a meaning or meaning, namely "by the way".* The word *btw* is usually used to insert a new topic or add information in a casual conversation.

Next said *Otw*. *Otw* said in data (4), the comment was written by the Aprilia12 @Sari account. The word *Otw* comes from the English language which is formed from the combination of each of the first phonemes "On The Way". This term has the meaning of "on the way" or "heading to the destination". The word *Otw* is usually used to tell that someone is heading somewhere. *Grwm* said in data (5), the comment was written by the @dianaaa account. The word *Grwm* comes from the English language which is formed from the combination of each of the first phonemes "Get Ready With Me". This term has the meaning of "getting ready with me". The word *Grwm* is usually used in social media content when someone wants to show the process of getting ready such as dressing up or choosing an outfit. Furthermore, said *Fyp*. *Fyp* said in data (6), the comment was written by the @ella^ account???. The word *Fyp* is an abbreviated form of slang formed from the combination of each of the first phonemes "For Your Page". This word comes from English which means a homepage or page for you which is recommended by the social media application we use, one of which is Tiktok. The word *Fyp* is usually used to refer to videos that enter the homepage of many people or that are going viral.

Cmiiw said in data (7), the comment was written by @heyen account. The word *Cmiiw* is an abbreviated form of slang formed from the combination of each of the first phonemes "Correct Me If I'm Wrong". The word comes from English which means "correct me if I'm wrong". The word *Cmiiw* is usually used when someone wants to express an opinion but remains open to correction. Next says *Pov*. *Pov* says in data (8), comments were written by @CumaUlatKecil account. The word *Pov* is an abbreviated form of slang formed from the combination of each of the first phonemes "Point Of View". This term has the meaning of "Point of View" or "way of looking at a situation from a certain perspective". On social media, this term is usually used to describe a situation as if the audience is in a certain position.

Next is the word *Php*. The word *Php* in data (9), the word *Php* is an abbreviated form slang formed from the combination of each of the first phonemes "False Hope-Giver". This term means that the person who gives hope is usually about feelings, but not really serious or not keeping them. *Oot* said in data (10), the comment was written by @Yeraxx account. The word *Oot* is an abbreviated form of slang formed from the combination of each of the first phonemes "Out Of Topic". This term comes from English which has a meaning, namely something that is talked about outside of the topic or not in accordance with the discussion being discussed. The word *Oot* is usually used when someone wants to convey something that is somewhat deviant from the main topic. Said *Fyi* in data (11), the comment was written by the account @cema1 cimil cimol. The word *Fyi* is an abbreviated form of slang formed from the combination of each of the first phonemes "For Your Information". This term comes from English which means "to inform" or "just to inform". The word *Fyi* is usually used to give additional information to someone in casual conversation.

Contractions

The results of the research on slang analysis in the comment column of the Tiktok account @Fadiljaidi found 8 forms of contraction. According to Muslich, (2008) Contraction is the process of forming words through shortening by removing some of the elements of the original word, so that a new, more concise unit is formed. Although the form is shorter, the contraction still retains the basic meaning of the original word so that it is still recognizable by the speaker. In the context of slang, contraction is widely used because it can speed up the delivery of messages while creating a more relaxed and familiar communication feel. Slang data on contraction forms are presented in table 3. The following.

Already said in data (1), the comment was written by @siapa account. The word *Udah* is a contraction of the word "Already" by omitting one phoneme, namely /s/. This term has a meaning, namely to indicate that an action, circumstance, or event has occurred or has been done. In addition, this word can also be used to signify that something has been enough or does not need to be continued. Furthermore, said Ampe. The word *Ampe* in data (2), the comment was written by the @d.r. The word *Ampe* is a contraction of the word "*Topa*" by omitting three phonemes, namely /s/, /a/, /i/. The word *Ampe* or *Until* has a meaning, namely to indicate a goal, limit, or state that has been achieved. In addition, this word can also be used to express a certain time, place, or level in an event or activity. In slang, the use of the word *Ampe* makes the conversation feel more relaxed and close between speakers.

Next said Bet. Bet said in data (3), the comments were written by @mutya account. The word *Bet* is a contraction of the word "*Banget*" by omitting three phonemes, namely /a/, /n/, /g/. This term has the meaning of "Very" or is used to emphasize a character, trait, or feeling. This word is usually used to reinforce the intention in a sentence, for example to express joy, sadness, funny, or admiration. Ege said in data (4), the comment was written by the @bilaaa_yeagerr-. account. The word *Ege* is a contraction of the word "*Bego*" by removing one phoneme, namely /b/ and replacing the phoneme /o/ with the phoneme /e/. In slang, this term is used to satirize or express dissatisfaction with someone who commits an unreasonable act. In addition, the word *bego* is also an informal form of the word "*stupid*".

Next, said Dikit. Dikit said in data (5), the comment was written by Nucahyani's @Afdhilaa account. The word *Dikit* is a contraction of the word "Little" by omitting two phonemes, namely /s/, /e/. The word *Dikit* has a meaning, namely to indicate a number, size, or level that is not much. In addition, this word can also be used to describe something that is only done in small amounts or a short time. Pen said in data (6), the comment was written by @re account. The word *Pen* is a contraction of the word "*Pengen*" or in Indonesian "*Ingin*" by eliminating three phonemes, namely /g/, /e/, /n/. This term has the meaning of wanting or having a desire for something.

Napa said in data (7), the comments were written by the @A-DIT account. The word *Napa* is a contraction of the word "Why" by omitting two phonemes, namely /k/, /e/. This term has a meaning, namely to ask for a reason or cause. The word *Napa* is usually used when you want to know why something happened. Furthermore, said Santuy. *Santuy* said in data (8), the comment was written by the @Pororo account. The word *Santuy* is a consequence of the word "*Relaxed*" by removing two phonemes, namely /a/, /i/ and replacing them with phonemes /u/, /y/. This term has the meaning of being calm, relaxed, and not in a hurry. Usually the word *Relaxed* is used to describe an atmosphere or attitude that is not tense and comfortable.

Clipping

The results of the research on slang analysis in the comment column of the Tiktok account @Fadiljaidi found 8 forms of clipping. According to Muslich, (2008) Clipping is the process of shortening words by taking a single syllable or a specific part of the original word, then making it a new form that stands on its own or can be called the

process of shrinking words. This form of shortening makes words simpler and easier to use in everyday conversation. Slang data of clipping form is presented in table 4. The following.

The word *Bro* in data (1), the comment was written by the @a account. *The word Bro* is a form of clipping with the first special syllable of the word "*Brother*". *The word bro* comes from English which means "brother". Furthermore, said *min*. *Min* said in (2), the comment was written by the @Mhc.Nicholszzy account. The word *Min* is a form of clipping with the last special syllable of the word "*Admin*". This term has a meaning, namely a designation for account managers, especially on social media, usually used to greet casually. Next is *improv*. *Improv* said in data (3), the comment was written by @Hi's account, Ry. The word *Improv* is a form of clipping with the first special syllable of the word "*Improvisation*". *This term comes from English which has the meaning of doing something spontaneously without preparation*. *The word toll* on data (4), comments were written by @ardhsu account. The word *Tol* is a form of clipping with the first special tribal taking of the word "*Tolol*". *This term has the meaning of calling someone stupid, but its use should be careful because it can offend others*.

The word *Eksek* in data (5), the comment was written by the @Labumanii account. The word *Ekspek* is a clipping form with the first special syllable of the word "*Expectation*". *In slang, the word eksek* has the meaning of not expecting something. Furthermore, *Indo* said in data (6), the comment was written by the @Deny Arden account. The word *Indo* is a form of clipping with the first special tribal taking of the word "*Indonesia*". *The word Indonesia* has a meaning, namely the name of a country located in Southeast Asia. *Gemoy* said in data (7), the comment was written by the @yourfav*< account. The word *Gemoy* is a form of clipping with taking the first special syllable of the word "*Gemas*" and adding the phonemes /o/, and /y/. *This term is usually used to describe something or someone who is considered cute and adorable*. Furthermore, the word *Auto* in data (8), the comment was written by the @Mann account. The word *Auto* is a clipping form with the first special syllable of the word "*Automatic*". *This word comes from English which has the meaning of to state something that immediately happens automatically or without long thought*. In slang, this word is used to emphasize a quick reaction.

Variety of Guardians

In the study on the analysis of slang forms in the comment column of the Tiktok account, @Fadiljaidi found 3 forms of walikan. According to Muslich, (2008) Walikan variety is a variation of language formed by reversing the phoneme arrangement in a word so as to produce a new form. Slang data on the form of various guardians is presented in the form of table 5. as follows.

Based on the data in the table above, there are three forms of walikan, namely *Ngab*, *Ucul*, *Sob*. *Ngab* said in data (1), the comment was written by the @syukron.jnh28 account. The word *Ngab* is a word "*Bang*" whose pronunciation or writing is reversed by changing the phoneme order from behind. The word *Bang* comes from the greeting "Brother" which is used to call older men or male friends familiarly. In its use, the word *Ngab* is used as a casual greeting for a friend, a man, or someone who is considered close. This term is widely used by teenagers in everyday conversations and in the comments section of social media to create a familiar and relaxed impression. Furthermore, *Ucul* said in data (2), the comment was written by @mayhira2 account. The word *Ucul* is a "funny" word whose pronunciation and writing are reversed by changing the phoneme order from behind. This word is used to give a more relaxed, unique, and adorable impression in everyday conversation. The word *Ucul* or *Cute* has the meaning of something that is entertaining, makes you laugh, or looks adorable. Usually this word is used to express a sense of excitement or admiration for the behavior of a person, animal, or a situation that is considered interesting or entertaining. Next, *Sob* said in (3), the comment was written by the @Essa account. The word *Sob* is a word "*Boss*" whose pronunciation or writing is reversed by changing the phoneme order from behind. The word *Boss* has a meaning, namely to refer to a superior, leader, or person who has authority in the job. In slang, the word *boss* is also often used as a casual greeting for friends such as calling "bro" or "buddy".

Conclusion

Based on the results of research on the form and meaning of the use of slang in the comment column of the Tiktok @Fadiljaidi account, it can be concluded that the slang used by netizens is very diverse and develops dynamically following the development of digital communication. This study found five forms of slang, namely acronyms, abbreviations, contractions, clippings, and various walikan. The most commonly found forms are abbreviations and acronyms, which indicate that social media users tend to use short, fast, and practical forms of language in communicating. The slang found is formed through various processes of shortening words, combining syllables, eliminating phonemes, and reversing the phoneme arrangement, in addition to being influenced by Indonesian, the use of slang is also heavily influenced by foreign languages, especially English which shows the influence of globalization and the development of social media on people's language patterns, especially teenagers. In terms of meaning, the use of slang in the comment column of the Tiktok account @Fadiljaidi not only serves as a communication tool, but also as a means to express emotions, jokes, familiarity, and social identity in the digital community. The use of slang creates a more relaxed, familiar, and interactive communication atmosphere between social media users. Thus, this study shows that slang is a form of language creativity that continues to develop in accordance with the communication needs of the community in the digital era.

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
